1. Browse available wireless networks and select as SSID 'eduroam-guest';
2. Set IP to automatic (DHCP). This is usually the default setting, so you may probably skip this step;

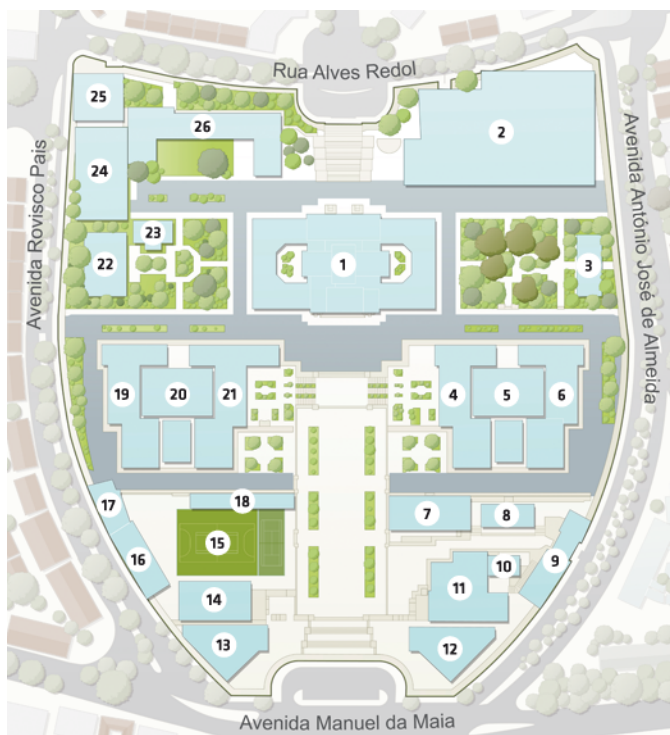
3. Open your browser and try to access any external website. You will be automatically redirected to the page https://wifi.ist.utl.pt/index_auth.php. Follow the link 'Web based login' at the top of the page concerning short-time, conference and meetings accounts. Enter the above username/password when requested;

4. After step 3 you may freely browse and access the Internet. You may need to repeat the above steps if you close your browser or if the connection times out.

The mathematics department is in building 24. There is a common room on the 3rd floor with a coffee machine (35 cents, exact change is required) and small whiteboards.

Getting around

Subway, the easiest for longer trips, runs daily from 6:30 am to 1 am. If you can read the maps at bus stops, buses are a good way to get around and to see the town. Subway and bus prepaid tickets can be purchased at a ticket office or a vending machine in subway stations: € .50 one-time charge for the rechargeable card, €1.40 for one trip on all network of bus or subway (it only charges you once in one hour), or €6 for a one day ticket (it includes unlimited trips during 24h). You may also use the *zapping* system. Scan your ticket at the gates both entering and leaving the subway, or each time you enter a bus.

If you get a taxi from the airport to IST, it should cost around €10. We recommend going upstairs to departures to get the taxi, rather than using a taxi waiting at arrivals. This should decrease your chances of being overcharged.

Lunch

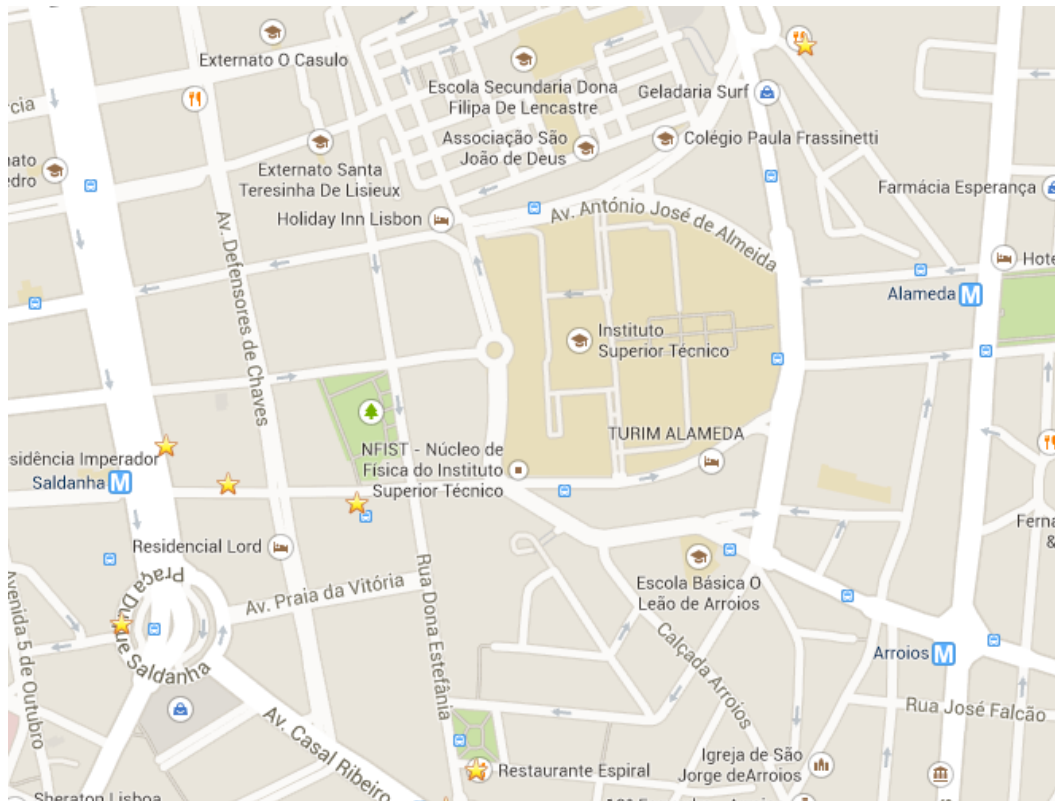
There are a few food options on campus.

- Cafeteria, floor 0 of the math building. Usually there are two choices of meat, two choices of fish and a vegetarian option. The menu also includes soup, juice, salad and dessert.
- Café with meals in *Complexo Interdisciplinar*.
- Bar, *Pavilhão de Civil* – with outdoor seating by the campus west entrance stairs (building 2)
- Cafeteria, *Pavilhão de Civil* (building 2)
- Café and restaurant *Versailles*, floor -1 of *Torre Norte* – northern black tower (building 5)

Food

For food options near campus:

1. *Monumental* – Praça Duque de Saldanha
mall with food court, lots of easy fast food options
2. *Espiral* – Praça Ilha do Faial 14, towards Estefânia
vegetarian and macrobiotic self-service, meal for about 8€
3. *Zaafraan* –Largo Dona Estefânia, good Indian food, vegetarian options,
lunch menus about 10€
4. *Mexicana* – Av. Guerra Junqueiro 30
classic café and restaurant with options from light to heavy steak
5. *Padaria Portuguesa* - Av. Duque d'Ávila 24
light meals such as sandwiches, soups or salads, lunch menus about 5€
6. *Vitamina e Sabores* – Av. Duque d'Ávila 45
large self-service restaurant with plenty of options, lunch menus about 10€
7. *Galeto* – Av. da República 14
extremely varied menu, seating at the counter, open daily from 7am to 3:30 am, 5-25€ depending on whether you have just a sandwich or a full meal



Some suggestions for dinner

€ - up to €20; €€ - between €20 and €40; €€€ - between €40 and €60.

On Fridays and Saturdays it is advisable to make a reservation in most of these restaurants.

1. *Spazio Buondi/Nobre* – Avenida Sacadura Cabral 53B | 217970760
Traditional Portuguese food. €€€
2. *People* – Campo Pequeno 42A e B | 217961298
Portuguese food. €
3. *Rubro* – Campo Pequeno | 210191191
Mediterranean food. €

Near Saldanha:

4. *À Parte* – Avenida Defensores de Chaves 14 C | 213543068
Portuguese food. €

Downtown:

5. *Lisboa à Noite* – Rua das Gáveas, 69 | 213468557
In Bairro Alto, in a building that once served as the stables of the Palácio dos Condes, offers contemporary cuisine with authentic Portuguese flavours. €€
6. *Pap'Açorda* - Rua da Atalaia 57 | 21 346 4811
In Bairro Alto, it is a traditional restaurant offering Portuguese cuisine. It takes its name from a specialty dish - a soupy bread and seafood mixture. €€€

7. *Sea Me* – Rua do Loreto 21 | 213461564/65
 Located in Chiado, it is a seafood restaurant. Everything served is the fresh “catch of the day” from various locations of the Portuguese coast. It is cooked in various ways, but essentially in a traditionally Portuguese style. From Thursday to Saturday, it stays open until 2AM and is also a nightlife destination, allowing you to stay until late with a glass of wine. €€
8. *Taberna Moderna* – Rua dos Bacalhoeiros 18 A/B/C | 218865039
 The food is all about sharing, just like in a traditional “tabern.” All offers are traditional Portuguese, some with a modern touch. It is located near Alfama, just next to the historic “Casa dos Bicos.” €
9. *Santo António de Alfama* – Beco de São Miguel 7 | 218881328
 Located in Alfama in a beautiful courtyard, it offers traditional Portuguese gastronomy. €
10. *Taberna Ideal*– Rua da Esperança 112-114 | 213962744
 Located in Santos, the atmosphere is relaxed and informal just like in a traditional “tabern.” It offers good traditional Portuguese cuisine always made with fresh products. €
11. *Aura* – Praça do Comércio - Terreiro do Paço | 213469447
 Located in Praça do Comércio, it offers Portuguese gastronomy surrounded by stunning architecture facing the Tagus river. €€
12. *Faz Figura* – Rua do Paraíso 15B | 218868981
 Located near Alfama, it offers contemporary Portuguese food, with fabulous views of the Tagus river. €€€
13. *Mercado de Campo de Ourique* – Rua Coelho da Rocha, Campo de Ourique
 Food and wine stands offer nice simple meals in a very popular and friendly market place (seafood, beef sandwiches, etc...). €
14. *Tasca da Esquina*– Rua Domingos Sequeira 41C | 210993939
 Located not far from Basilica da Estrela, this restaurant is owned by one of Lisbon's most famous chefs. It is a gourmet restaurant offering Portuguese cuisine. It's a very welcoming, informal place but still sophisticated due to the quality of the food and service. €€
15. *Cantinho do Aveliz*– Rua dos Duques de Bragança 7 | 211992369
 Located in Chiado, the cuisine is created by a Michelin starred chef. The choice is select but amazingly varied and largely Portuguese inspired. It is a casual drop-in spot, very informal where simple but sophisticated fare is served promptly and without fuss. €€

Fado Places:

16. *Clube do Fado*– Rua São João da Praça 86-94 | 218852704
 Located next to the Cathedral Sé, this is a topnotch fado place, with Portuguese traditional cooking. €€€
17. *Mesa de Frades* – Rua dos Remédios 139a | 917029436
 Located in Alfama, it is used to be a chapel. It's tiled with azulejos and has just a handful of tables. Informal atmosphere and simple menu. Show begins around 11pm. €€
18. *Fado Maior*–Lago do Peneireiro 7 | 218877508
 Located in Alfama, it offers simple traditional Portuguese food. Opens on Fridays and Saturdays. €€

Vegetarian:

19. *Terra* –Rua da Palmeira 15| 213421407
Located in Príncipe Real, near Bairro Alto.€
20. *Psi* – Alameda Santo António dos Capuchos| 213590573
Surrounded by a public garden. €
21. *Tibetanos* – Rua do Salitre 117| 213142038
Part of a Buddhist center, this restaurant has pure vegetarian options. €
22. *Jardim dos Sentidos* – Rua da Mãe d'Água 3 | 213423670
Located near Príncipe Real. €
